He also served as a producer for the Christian writer/producer Mark Cramer, who created Silver Lining Films.

He further assisted Scott Alan Mendes of UnBranded Productions, a film production studio focused on producing period pieces and Contemporary Christian Films and television projects.

From 2019- 2021 Ed worked with Shelly Paino and Hannah Ratnam on the screen play, "Hannah's Dream".
